TERMS OF COMPETITION & LOCAL RULES

1. Entry Conditions

The Championship is open to male and female amateur golfers as defined by the current R&A Rules of Amateur Status.

All competitors must be members of a golf club which itself is a member of its national federation/union/association and/or be in possession of a valid Golf Hcp Card.

Entries are open until June 21st 2023 at 18h:00.

The Championship Committee retains the right to revise the criteria in special cases or reject any entry without giving reason for its decision.

2. Format and Competition Categories

The players, both Man and Ladies, will compete in following Categories;

- A) WAGR Macedonian Open Championship Man - Gross Medal
WAGR Macedonian Open Championship Ladies – Gross Medal
- B) Golden Plate Division Macedonian Open Championship – Gross, Net Medal
- C) Silver Plate Division Macedonian Open Championship, - Net Stableford

The Championship shall comprise of 54 holes; of stroke play for Categories A & B and Net Stableford for Category C.

First three places will be announced in each Category

3. Handicap (Hcp) Limits, Man and Women

- Category A Man- Max Hcp 12
- Category A Ladies - Max Hcp 18
- Category B - Max Hcp 28
- Category C - Max Hcp 36

Players with higher Hcp than above limits will play with maximum Hcp allowed in each category.

4. Tees

- Category A Man - Championship Tees (Back Tees) / **white**
- Category A Ladies - Championship Ladies Tees / **blue**
- Category B - Front Tees / **men-yellow, ladies-red**
- Category C - Front Tees / **men-yellow, ladies-red**

5. Prizes

Macedonian Golf Federation offers men's and women's trophies rewarding the winners in all three Categories; A, B and C.

- Macedonian Amateur Champion - Overall Gross Winner Man
- Macedonian Amateur Champion - Overall Gross Ladies
- Golden Plate Macedonian Champion - Winner Gross and Net
- Silver Plate Macedonian Champion - Stableford Net

Special prize will be awarded to Best Gross score among Macedonian nationality players.

6. Number of Players

Tournament is limited to maximum 164 players, Man and Women combined.

7. Decision of Ties

In the event of a tie for the first place Overall Gross Winner and MidAm Gross Winner after three rounds, winners shall be decided by hole-by-hole play-off stroke play (sudden death) starting from hole No. 1.

All other ties will be decided by matching scorecards based on the best scores for the final 18, 9, 6, 3 holes or last hole in that order. If a tie still exists, an 18-hole count-back will be used on the second round, if necessary.

GENERIC TERMS OF COMPETITION & REGULATIONS

1. Rules

The championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf approved by R&A Rules Ltd., the specific Terms of Competition & Local Rules and the Generic Terms of Competition & Regulations herein.

2. Championship Committee

The MGF Championship Committee members present are responsible for the sporting aspect of the event and reserve the right to amend the Terms of the Competition.

The committee may appoint Referees whose decision on the Rules of Golf will be final.

Members: Andrey Glushkov, Ivan Mishevski, Todor Kocevski

Head Referee: Borislav Todorovic

Referees: Nominated by the Championship Committee.

3. Authorization of Entries

All entries are subject to the approval of the Championship Committee, which reserves the right to disqualify any competitor making false statement at his entry and to accept or refuse or, having accepted, subsequently reject any entry without giving reason for its decision.

4. Behaviour

Players, advise givers, caddies, should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times. Breaching the EGA and MGF Conduct Guidelines may be subject to disciplinary action by the Championship Committee.

5. Caddies

Player is allowed to have a caddie during the round. Caddy must not be a PRO.

6. Prompt Pace of Play

Pace of Play condition will apply.

7. Penalty for breach the rule

- First time breach - Verbal warning from a Rule Official
- Second time breach - One stroke penalty
- Third time breach - Two strokes penalty

Fourth time - Disqualification

Above is applicable on the golf round basis.

8. Carts

Only players competing in the Plate divisions may use carts.

9. Starting Time

The Championship Committee reserves the right to set and/or alter starting times.

10. Player Starting Time

Competitor who shall not be present at the starting Tee when called upon to start shall be disqualified.

11. Distance Measuring Device

Distance Measuring Devices are allowed during tournament play, provided conditions stated in Rule 4.3 are observed.

12. Equipment

Participants are obliged to use golf balls and golf clubs that are listed as conforming with the Rules of Golf on the R&A Rules Ltd web-site www.randa.org

13. Disputes and Complains

All disputes/complains must be referred to the Head Referee who will resolve them by use of the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A GC of St. Andrews.

If not possible to be resolved, the Head Referee will address the matter to Championship Committee.

14. Anti-Doping

A competitor must not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance his performance. A competitor must, if requested, submit to a random drug test. Failure to do so may result in disqualification. The regulation of Macedonian Olympic Committee (MOK) apply.

15. Disclaimer

All players agree that there are certain risks inherent in the game of golf and accept personal and sole responsibility for all such risks.
